

# Hamza Yousfi | Senior Full-Stack Engineer

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## Professional Summary:

Senior Full-Stack Software Engineer with 5+ years building and scaling production web platforms across healthtech, fintech, e-commerce, and enterprise SaaS. I specialize in web technologies, working mainly with TypeScript, React, Next.js, Node.js, and NestJS, with a focus on making delivery faster and safer. I own what I build end-to-end, from architecture and third-party integrations through deployment and post-release support, and I mentor junior developers so the standards hold beyond my own pull requests. I also design agentic coding workflows that let small teams ship significantly more features to production while cutting human review cycles. Alongside that, I audit and optimize application performance, cutting page load and API response times by up to 90% on data-heavy platforms, and I integrate AI into products where it removes real work for the people using them.

- Delivered an end-to-end e-prescription feature fully in TypeScript across a NestJS microservice and a React, Redux (with sagas) frontend, integrating a third-party prescription API ([Ordoclic LAP](#)) so physicians preview and select prescription templates in-app before launching the external tool, and designing a stable DTO contract that shields the product from the vendor's undocumented payloads.
- Fixed a flaky E2E suite that failed ~15% of all pipeline runs, forcing multiple 7-min re-runs on a 15-min GitLab CI pipeline. Traced Elasticsearch indexing race conditions and time-boundary cases, replaced blind waits with deterministic readiness polling, and fixed the production bug the flakiness had masked. Audited the rest of the suite for at-risk tests to prevent future recurrence.
- Migrated doctors' specialty-filtering logic from the web and mobile apps into the search microservice, making the backend the single source of search rules and ending a release chain where every change forced redeployments and mobile updates. Rolled it out safely and progressively behind an Unleash feature flag mirrored front-to-back, with an instant fallback to the legacy behavior.
- Contributed to an AI-powered telehealth platform using the [OpenAI API](#) to automate clinical documentation and streamline patient intake, reducing administrative load on practitioners: built small features and served as support point of contact, shipping hotfixes and patches, and channeling recurring friction into internal UX improvements for a more intuitive experience.
- Built my own AI agentic coding workflow using [Claude Code](#) on a production healthcare platform, leveraging skills, plugins, and ADR-backed context files persisting architectural decisions across sessions; automated sub-agents enforce spec compliance, codebase guidelines, and coding standards before human review, cutting review cycles and increasing safe production delivery.
